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Blood Collection Order Of Drawing

Tubes with green tops have lithium heparin anticoagulant. Lavender, Purple, Tall Pink – EDTA. The EDTA anticoagulant in tubes with lavender or purple stopper helps remove calcium by forming calcium salts. This draw is often used in blood bank cross-matching and hematology. Gray – Sodium Fluoride, Potassium Oxalate.

Phlebotomy Order of Draw. Phlebotomists must collect blood samples using collection tubes in a specific order while performing venipuncture on patients to avoid cross-contamination of the various additives between tubes. This process is known as the order of draw. Unfortunately for entry-level phlebotomists or those in phlebotomy training, this process can be quite confusing and

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often difficult to remember.

This order of draw has changed over the years, the last occurring in 2003. Necessitating the change was the industry-wide transition from glass blood collection tubes to plastic. Whereas glass is a natural clot activator, plastic is not. So in order for blood to clot in safer plastic tubes, manufacturers coat the inside of the tube with a ...

The draw order for specimen tubes is as follows: Blood culture. Blue tube for coagulation (Sodium Citrate) Red No Gel. Gold SST (Plain tube w/gel and clot activator additive) Green and Dark Green (Heparin, with and without gel) Lavender (EDTA) Pink - Blood Bank (EDTA) Gray (Oxalate/Fluoride)

Order of Draw. When drawing blood for multiple tube collections, it is important to take into consideration proper venipuncture technique and correct order of draw. Taking these factors seriously can lessen discomfort and complications for your patient, lessen procedure time, and prevent errors in diagnosis caused by cross contamination of additives between blood collection tubes.

Newborns do not bleed immediately do not squeeze excessively as this will dilute blood. Wipe away the first drop of blood then begin the collection. Heel stick order of draw is different from a venipuncture collection: Collect the lavender top tube first. Next, draw the chemistry and blood bank tubes.

Incorrect order of draw — when filling EDTA tubes before filling tubes to be tested for K⁺, enough blood can carry over by the needle that pierces the stopper to spike the potassium to grossly distorted levels.
