## Counterfactual decomposition of changes in wage ...

Specifically, it decomposes the changes in the wage distribution over a period of time into several factors contributing to those changes, namely by discriminating between changes in the characteristics of the working population and changes in the returns to these characteristics.

## Counterfactual Decomposition of Changes in Wage ...

Counterfactual decompositions allow the researcher to analyze the changes in wage distributions by discriminating between the effect of changes in the population characteristics and the effect of changes in returns to these characteristics.

## **RIF- Regression Unconditional Quantile Regression ...**
