if the person or thing is preceded by the preposition *à* or *pour*, that person/thing is an indirect object. If it's not preceded by a preposition, it is a direct object. If it's preceded by any other preposition, it can't be replaced by an object pronoun.

Indirect pronouns have the function of indirect object. Therefore, they are used when the verb is followed by the preposition " *a* " (to) and they answer the question "To whom? To what?". For example: *Miriana ha telefonato a Luca* = *Miriana gli ha telefonato* (Miriana phoned Luca = Miriana phoned him). In this

case, the indirect pronoun gli replaces the indirect object: “a Luca”.
