Follow Up On Your Job Application With This Easy Template ...

Things You Should and Shouldn't Do While Waiting to Hear ...

In the subject line, include the job title you interviewed for. Send this email to the recruiter. They are the most likely to be up-to-date on what's going on in the hiring process. Keep it to one paragraph indicating that you are still interested in the job and looking for an update.

Start by identifying the keywords (usually skills) that recruiters are likely to search for and include these on your LinkedIn profile and any CVs you may have uploaded onto a database or job board.
