Snug the strap down, but do not compress the shock. Remove the right shock. Using the upper bolt only (Don't forget the BLUE Loctite!), mount the right shock. Use the strap to compress the left shock until you can install the right lower bolt (again with BLUE Loctite). Torque the bolts to spec. Remove the left shock. Install the left shock.
