The last version of Windows NT to have an OS/2 subsystem was Windows 2000; it was removed as of Windows XP. The POSIX environment subsystem supports applications that are strictly written to either the POSIX.1 standard or the related ISO / IEC standards. This subsystem has been replaced by Interix, which is a part of Windows Services for UNIX.
