The MOT test is an annual test of vehicle safety, roadworthiness aspects and exhaust emissions required in the United Kingdom for most vehicles over three years old used on any way defined as a road in the Road Traffic Act 1988; it does not apply only to highways but includes other places available for public use, which are not highways. In Northern Ireland the equivalent requirement applies after four years. The requirement does not apply to vehicles used only on various small islands with no c

Use inspection lamp and check; Driver's foot well area, rock steering wheel, (engine still running if PAS) and check steering column and U/Js etc., pedal box condition and security, side to side movement of pedals, anti-slip provision on brake pedal, rods, levers, clevises, locking devices etc. Prescribed Areas (Inspection may necessitate moving over to passenger side if there is a cross shaft)
